

# Operating the Cassette Converter

1. Open the tape player, insert the tape, and close it.



2. Using the tape player's controls, make sure your tape is rewound all the way to its beginning.



3. Click the **EZ Vinyl Converter** icon on the dock at the bottom of the screen to open it.



4. Follow the onscreen instructions, making sure to select **Tape Player** as your audio device.

5. After you have finished recording, named the artist and album, and titled the tracks, Open **iTunes**.



6. The audio you have ripped will be located in your iTunes library. You may drag the files onto a flashdrive, harddrive, or burn them to a CD.

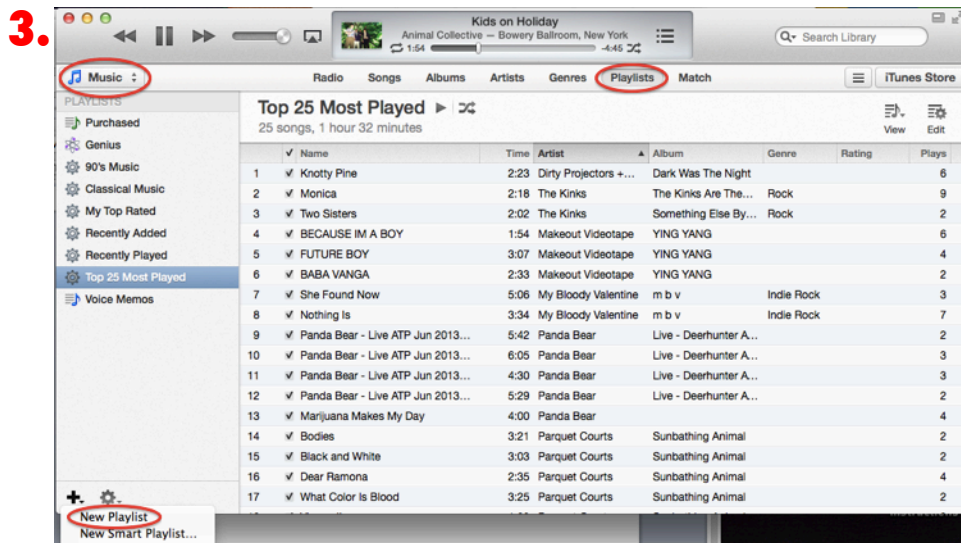
# Burning an Audio CD Using iTunes

1. Click the **iTunes** icon on the dock at the bottom of the screen.

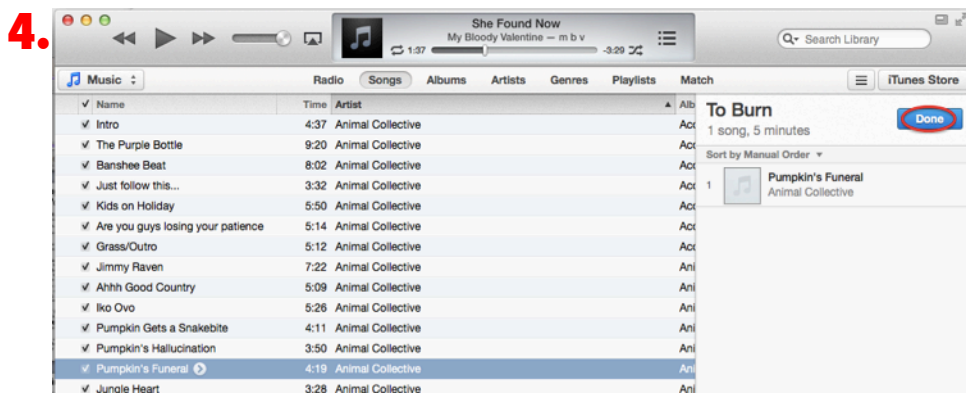


2. Import the tracks you would like to burn into iTunes (drag them into the iTunes window).

3. Under **Music** go to **Playlists**, click the plus at the bottom right, and select **New Playlist**.

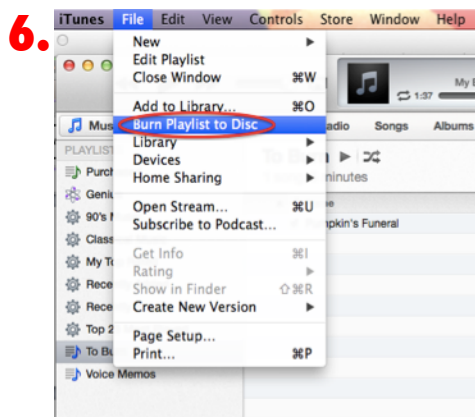


4. The playlist will show up on the right side of the window, name it and drag the tracks you want to burn into it. Once you have added all the tracks you want, click **Done** (CDs can record up to 80 minutes).



5. Insert a blank CD into the disc drive.

6. In iTunes, under the **File** menu select **Burn Playlist to Disc**.



7. Click **Burn**, when the CD is done burning click the eject button on the top right of the Keyboard.
