Oh do you love the beagle dog, the beagle dog, the beagle dog?

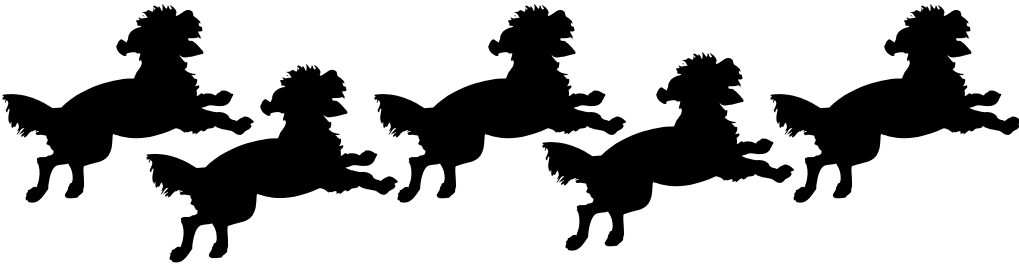
If you love the beagle dog,

Oh do you love the chocolate lab, the chocolate lab, the chocolate lab?

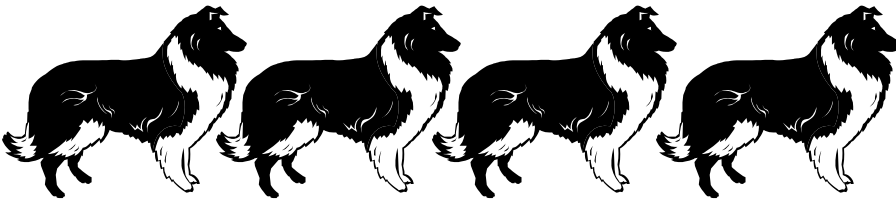
If you love the chocolate lab,

or used with a flannel board at the appropriate verse.*

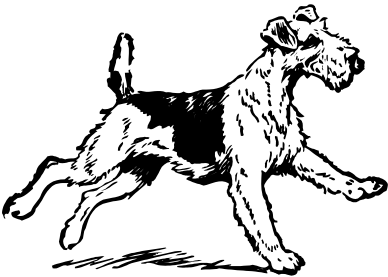
Count the dogs and draw a line to the matching number.



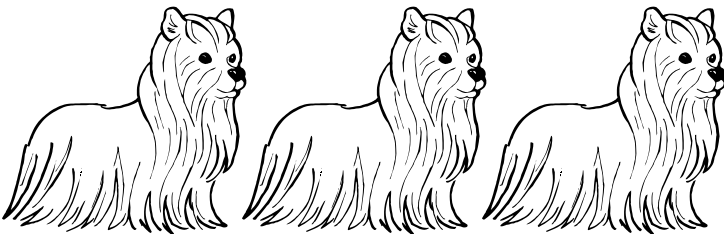

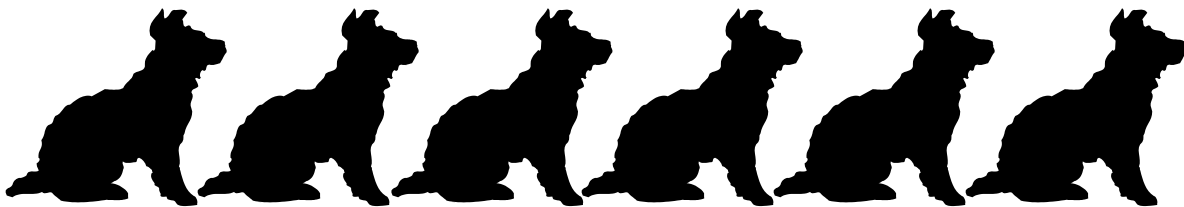

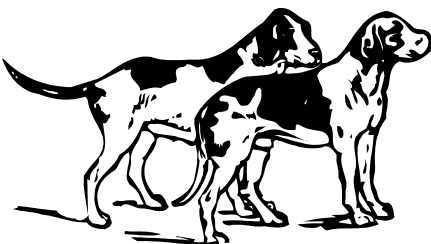
